
2021 Shelby County Community Partnership Grant Guidelines

Mission Statement

The purpose of the Shelby County Community Foundation is to enrich the quality of life of all citizens of Shelby County by serving the charitable interests of donors who have established charitable funds as part of a permanent, collective, philanthropic resource for the current and future needs of the Shelby County community.

Fund Information

The Shelby County Community Foundation is seeking grant proposals for the following funds established by bequest for the benefit of Shelby County.

1. Moses Ruben Fund for Shelby County (established in 1990)
2. H. Augustus and Austine T. Barnett Fund (created in 2003)
3. Mary Ellen Hackworth Fund (established in 2005)

Scope of Funding

Grants are awarded for a one-year period only. All awarded funds must be utilized during this period or be forfeited. Applicants are encouraged to obtain additional funding from other resources and not to seek 100 percent of the project funding from the Foundation. The Foundation reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to award grants of any amount, for any time period, and under any structure that it deems appropriate. Challenge and matching grants may be eligible for funding. Please note that grants will NOT be made to the following.

*Individuals *Endowments *Annual Fundraising *Capital Campaigns *Sectarian Purposes

Application Process

Any nonprofit organization which has a functional board of directors and proof of 501(c)(3) status is eligible to apply. Such an organization must submit a completed Grant Application Form by 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 30, 2021.

PLEASE NOTE: Incomplete or late grant applications will not be accepted. Faxed or emailed proposals will not be accepted. Original plus six (6) copies are required to submit a complete application. Failure to include the required number of copies will result in immediate disqualification.

Grant Review and Award Process

The Board of Directors, or the appropriate committee, will review all proposals. The Board may require a presentation or site visit to complete the application process. Grants will be announced in early November 2021.
